Example: heat exhaustion or immobilizing injury	Low	Med	Physical and gear check. Staff sets pace, picks route and monitors Trailmen.	Treat locally with first responder First Aid. If severe, contact base for medical consult, evacuate to medical facility
Lost Traílman	Hígh	Med	Repeated briefings by staff, Troop Leaders; Buddy system enforced; ESAR training or orientation of Troop Leaders and Staff at initial orientation.	ESAR trained staff and leaders on site gather information and organize search. Local resources called if necessary (EMERGENCY # 012-345-6789)
Vehícle híttíng Traílman	Low	Hígh	Vehicles not allowed to drop off Trailmen at site – limiting of vehicles and no vehicles in camping areas; supply deliveries in locations and/or at times not frequented by Trailmen; Signs for event "Slow" and"5 mph" posted at entrance and on roads.	Treat locally with first responder First Aid. If severe, contact base for medical consult, evacuate to medical facility. EMERGENCY #'s: County Police: 987- 654-3210; EMS/Hospital: 546-231-8907
Fíre	Low	Medíum	No open fires allowed except in designated places – campfire bowl, fire making event; leave no trace theme; backpacking or propane stoves for cooking; shovels, rakes and water buckets in vicinity of any open fires	use of shovels, rakes, and accessible water to extinguish fire; in the event of additional assistance, contact Camp HQ/Ranger; Fire Dept emergency # 123- 457-6890
Shooting Sports	Low	Hígh	Follow all rules and requirements in HSG for Shooting Sports activities	Treat locally with first responder First Aid. If severe, contact base for medical consult, evacuate to medical facility. EMERGENCY #'s: County Police: 987- 654-3210; EMS/Hospital: 546-231-8907
